



The Party No. 1 is a University operating Medical College & Hospital with Graduate and Post Graduate & Doctoral Courses in various subjects

The Party No. 2 is a Medical College run by Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati is a Teaching College & Hospital with Graduate and Post Graduate & Doctoral Courses in various subjects, having well developed Teaching Hospital with all Investigative & Treatment Facilities including Intensive care Facilities and Emergency Services and Super speciality services.

Both the parties have entered this M.O.U. for Mutual Academic Benefits and to avail the facilities of other party for the Academic & Research Benefits of the Students and Staff.

**NOW THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION OF THE FOREGOING AND OF THE MUTUAL CONVENANTS CONTAINED HEREIN THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOES:**

- 1) The period of this M.O.U will be for 5 (five) years from date of signing this agreement and renewable unless either party give notice of termination not later than one month prior to the expiration of the existing Memorandum of Understanding. However, either party can also terminate by giving notice of termination not less than one month.
- 2) Both the parties will permit the UG and PG students of other Party to visit the other's campus and observe the procedures being done there, participate in academic activities and research work.
- 3) Participation of the students in academic activities will be free of cost for both the parties.

- 4) Joint Research work can be planned, conducted and published jointly by both parties (staff and students) under intimation to both heads of the institutions.
- 5) With mutual understanding any other joint projects/ activities can be undertaken by both the parties for the academic & research benefit of students/ staff of both parties.
- 6) Intellectual Property jointly conceived and/or developed by ANNA MEDICAL COLLEGE and Dr. PANJABRAO DESHMUKH MEMORIAL MEDICAL COLLEGE, HOSPITAL & RESEARCH CENTER will be jointly owned by ANNA MEDICAL COLLEGE and Dr. PANJABRAO DESHMUKH MEMORIAL MEDICAL COLLEGE, HOSPITAL & RESEARCH CENTER.
- 7) ANNA MEDICAL COLLEGE and Dr. PANJABRAO DESHMUKH MEMORIAL MEDICAL COLLEGE, HOSPITAL & RESEARCH CENTER agree to collaborate towards the protection, if appropriate, and application of such intellectual property for Academic and Research purposes on mutually acceptable terms to be negotiated in good faith between the parties.
- 8) Both the parties will be entitled for exchange of staff and students for research, teaching, interdisciplinary academic & research activities on deputation basis or as decided mutually.
- 9) Both the parties will be entitled for mutual co-operation in regard to national integration, cultural and sports activities.
- 10) Both the parties will issue permission letter as and when required to facilitate entry of the students or faculties into their respective countries (India/Mauritius) for their short time stay and academic activity.
- 11) Both the parties will arrange subsidized accommodation and food for the students of other party in their residential campus on arrival.
- 12) Teaching staff will certify the log book of academic activities of students. On completion of activity each institute will issue a certificate to this effect mutually both to the student/ faculty and the other institute.
- 13) Concerned deputed student/ faculty will bear all the expenses incurred toward transport, stay, food, health care, etc. Institute sending student/ faculty can extend the financial assistance to its own student or faculty. The receiving institute will not bear any expenses towards this.






14) No modification to this MoU shall be binding unless made in writing and signed by both parties.

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

AND Dr.Panjabrao alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh Memorial Medical College, Amravati a Medical College –teaching instate formed  
And registered having their place of work at add- Panchawati Square, Gadge Nagar Amravati  
RECITALS:  
Rainbow Institute of Medical Sciences. Hospital is desirous to conduct research in the Area of Medical & Clinical fields for and by DNB students.

2. **Dr.Panjabrao alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh Memorial Medical College, Amravati** is a teaching institute and has an in-house Institutional Ethics Committee and would be involved in the same to the extent laid down in this MOU.

3. The outcome measures of the project shall be conducted through analytical tools, Preliminary information, and the findings will be helpful for DNB academicians

NOW IT IS AGREED BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:-

1. PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVE OF THE RESEARCH / PROJECT

1.1 To examine the feasibility/ develop and validate analytical methods in research conducted by DNB students.

1.2 To do all things necessary to complete the project or feasibility study. To the extent necessary, and to collect and analyze the data for the expected outcome measures.

2. ARRANGEMENT

2.1 It is agreed and understood that **Rainbow Institute of Medical Sciences, Hospital** shall do research through DNB student.

2.2 It is agreed and understood that **Dr.Panjabrao alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh Memorial Medical College, Amravati** shall extend support of its institution Ethics committee. It is agreed that the parties associate exclusively for the purpose of this project within the region specified.

2.3 Each party agrees and undertakes that they party will not enter into or in any way seek an award of any contract for the project or any part thereof other than in accordance with this MOU without the written consent of the other party hereto.

2.4 The parties hereto **Rainbow Institute of Medical Sciences, And Dr.Panjabrao alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh Memorial Medical College, Amravati** shall have no objection to the use of the data collected the project for research purposes as is required under the project.



### 3. RESPONSIBILITIES

- 3.1 **The Rainbow Institute of Medical Sciences.** will act as the conductor of the research activity for the feasibility of the study and will control and manage the day to day activities necessary for the study.
- 3.2 **Rainbow Institute of Medical Sciences. LTD.** shall also recruit the participants for the study and the persons responsible for the same.
- 3.3 The persons responsible for recruiting will also be responsible for taking informed consent and for taking samples / drawing blood for testing purposes for the study.
- 3.4 **Dr. Panjabrao alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh Memorial Medical College, Amravati 's Ethics Committee** shall supervise co-ordination of the study and conducting the laboratory experimental work in the project/ study.
- 3.5 The persons responsible for the laboratory work shall also be responsible for the proper handling of the human samples, clinical materials, etc.

### 4. CONFIDENTIALITY

- 4.1 The parties and the persons responsible and working on the project shall keep confidential all information relating to the project that is confidential in nature, including the participants' details, test reports, etc. Confidentiality of participants shall be maintained in all publication of the study too.
- 4.2 No confidential information shall be revealed to any third person without the express written consent of the party or participant whose information is confidential in nature.
- 4.3 Use of confidential information for any purpose other than the said purpose of the project shall not be allowed, unless all parties agree and give written consent for the same.



4.4 No public announcement, press release, public statement, etc. shall be made about the study / project till its final completion and without the consent of all parties involved in the project.

4.5 Parties shall conform to the guidelines for research, good clinical practice and medical ethics and shall not breach the same.

## 5. CONSIDERATION

5.1 There is no financial consideration to be paid by either of the parties to this MOU. The funding received for this project shall be utilized for purpose only and accounts for the same shall be submitted to the funding agency after due audit.

5.2 Rainbow Institute of Medical Sciences, shall bear the expenses for the research activities and Dr. Panjabrao alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh Memorial Medical College, Amravati shall only extend the support of its Institutional Ethics Committee.

5.3 If any compensation needs to be provided to the participants, it shall be borne by the Rainbow Institute of Medical Sciences only.

## 6. OWNERSHIP OR CREDIT OF THE STUDY/ RESEARCH/ PROJECT

6.1 It is agreed that the ownership and credit for the research project shall be shared by all the parties involved in the project handling, execution and analysis of the same.

6.2 Ethical review of the research project shall be done and all rules and regulations shall be followed strictly by all parties.

7. The governing law shall be the law applicable in India for the time being in force. If there is a dispute or difference on the ownership or credentials of the project, or any other aspect of the project or as to the rights and responsibilities and obligations of the parties hereto, the same shall be referred to the common Arbitrator/ Ethics Committee, as agreed upon by both parties, for resolving the dispute and the decision of the said arbitrator shall be final and binding on all parties. The agreement of the arbitrator shall be governed under the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 for the time being in force. The venue for such arbitration shall be Mumbai, India.

8. Any notice under this MOU or change of persons in charge or responsible for the projects, shall be sent to the other party in writing by either post, email, facsimile or delivered by hand. The notice to the party should be sent at the address mentioned in this MOU.

9. The MOU shall be terminated at the completion of the project In case for some reason it is stopped or terminated prior to completion by either party, reason for the same would have to be given in writing and approval from the Ethics Committee and any other concerned authority for the same would have to be taken. Decision on the impact of such termination on the participants would also have to be assessed and appropriate compensation would have to be paid by the party terminating the project prior to its completion.

10. The entire MOU constitutes the final and concluded agreement between the parties. It replaces all other, if any, MOUs or agreements signed for the above said project, whether in oral or in writing. Deshmukh, Dean (hereinafter singly referred to as "PDMMCH") which term unless repugnant to the context there of shall mean and include its successors and permitted assigns etc.) of the Other Part.

**WHEREAS:**

**WHEREAS 'Siddharth Gupta Memorial Cancer Hospital'** (hereinafter referred to as **Care Provider**), **A Hospital affiliated with Acharya Vinoba Bhave Rural Hospital (NABH accredited)** is a 120 bedded state-of-the-art cancer hospital providing excellent cancer treatment to patients in the field of Radiation, Surgical & Medical Oncology, Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery, Pain & palliative care.

**WHEREAS SGMCH** is proficient in dealing with cancer of Head & Neck, Lung & Esophagus (Food Pipe), Stomach and Colon (Large Intestine), Liver, Gall Bladder and Pancreas, Kidney, Bladder, Prostate, Gynecological Tumors, Blood Cancer and Lymphomas, Pediatric Cancer, Breast Cancer, Skin Cancer, Sarcoma (Bone Cancer) etc.

**WHEREAS SGMCH** facilities includes fully equipped Laboratory for cancer Investigations which includes Clinical Biochemistry, Clinical Microbiology and Serology, Clinical Pathology, Cytopathology, Haematology, Histopathology, Immuno- Histochemistry, Molecular Pathology, Clinical Haematology, Blood Transfusion Services. In House facility for radiological investigations like MRI (3Tesla), CT (64 Slices), X-RAY, USG, ECHO, Mammography, State of Art Modular OT Complex, Daycare Unit, General Ward, Special Private Rooms (Single and Twin sharing). Clinical support services includes Psychology, Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy, Speech and Language Therapy, Blood Bank & 24 x 7 Emergency Department, Pharmacy, & Ambulance facility etc.

**WHEREAS PDMMCH** is engaged in the field of **Tertiary healthcare provider** having its 830 bedded multi & super specialty teaching hospital attached to **Dr. Panjabrao Alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh Memorial medical college** (hereinafter referred to as referring Hospital)

**WHEREAS** the Parties are now desirous of entering into this **MOU** to record the terms of the agreement and the roles and responsibilities to be performed by the parties, during the performance of such agreement and the mutual rights and obligations between the Parties mentioned therein.

**NOW, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL COVENANTS AND AGREEMENTS SET FORTH IN THIS AGREEMENT THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:**

**1. SCOPE OF SERVICE:**

1. PDMMCH agrees to refer cancer patients to SGMCH requiring Radiation therapy for External Beam Radiation Therapy (LINAC) and Internal Radiation Therapy (HDR Brachytherapy) which shall include:

- Intensity Modulated Radiation Therapy (IMRT)
- Image Guided Radiation Therapy (IGRT)
- IMRT + IGRT
- Volumetric Modulated Arc Therapy (VMAT)
- 3D Conformal Radiation Therapy (3D-CRT)
- Adjuvant Treatment with Photon
- Palliative Treatment with Photon



- Short Course Palliative Radiotherapy
  - HDR Brachytherapy for Intra-Cavitary and Interstitial Applications.
2. Cancer patients referred to SGMCH from PDMMCH will be eligible for concession of 30% on OPD consultation and 15% on Radiation package and IPD bill as per Radiation Techniques specifically mentioned in clause 1 in pursuant thereof.
  3. Patients referred from PDMMCH for radiation therapy are eligible for Mahatma Jyotiba Phule Jan Arogya Yojna (hereinafter referred to as MJJAY) Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojna (hereinafter referred to as PMJAY) & shall be treated as per MJJAY/PMJAY & SGMCH policy.
  4. Patients referred from PDMMCH for radiation shall be referred to SGMCH Tumor Board in order to ensure best medical treatment of care and same shall be informed to referring department of PDMMCH immediately.
  5. Patients referred from PDMMCH for radiation will be treated on priority basis & ensure to undertaken all the diagnostic Investigations.
  6. Apart from Radiation therapy, SGMCH shall provide all emergency care services to patients in a manner that is consistent with, the prevailing standard of care, and in the same professional manner and pursuant to the same professional standards as are generally furnished to all patients in accordance thereof.
  7. SGMCH shall raise invoice/bill and collect payments directly from patients towards radiation treatment after deducting applicable charges/concession as specifically mentioned in clause 2.
  8. SGMCH further ensure to provide quality services to patients referred by PDMMCH as per standard medical practice.

## 2. DURATION OF AGREEMENT







### Memorandum of Understanding

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) IS MADE WITH RENEWAL FROM \_\_\_\_\_ AT AMRAVATI ON THIS \_\_\_\_\_ DAY OF \_\_\_\_\_ BY AND BETWEEN :

1. THE VIDARBHA YOUTH WELFARE SOCIETY, AMRAVATI, a society duly incorporated under the provisions of the societies Registration Act and Bombay Public Trust Act, through its Chairman along with the Dental College, Amravati through its Dean (hereinafter referred to as "The Dental College" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, be deemed to include its successors and permitted assigns) of the SECOND PART:
2. SHRI SHIVAJI EDUCATION SOCIETY, AMRAVATI, a society duly incorporated under the provisions of the Societies Registration, Act and Bombay Public Trust Act. through its Chairman along with Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Memorial Medical College, Amravati through its Dean, (hereinafter referred to as "The Medical College" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, be deemed to include its successors and permitted assigns) of the FIRST PART:

WHEREAS, the Medical College has its own hospital and teaching staff duly recognized by the National Medical Commission and conducts undergraduate medical course leading to M.B.B.S. Degree and also affiliated to the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

AND WHEREAS, the Dental College does not has its own hospital and the Dental College conducts a Dental Course leading to B.D.S. degree recognized by the Dental Council of India and is also affiliated to the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

AND WHEREAS, the Dental College requires in terms of the regulations framed by the Dental Council of India, a hospital for teaching and training the students of BDS and MDS (Post Graduate) courses, is desirous of utilizing the following departments of the Medical College namely :

1. General Human Anatomy & Histology
2. Human Physiology
3. Biochemistry
4. Gen. Pathology
5. Microbiology
6. Pharmacology
7. Gen. Medicine
8. Gen. Surgery
9. Anesthesia

AND WHEREAS, the parties hereto have agreed that the Medical Hospital facilities of 100 beds of the Medical College shall also be made available for the clinical training to the BDS students-presently the 3<sup>rd</sup> year students in the subject of General Medicine and General Surgery and the facilities shall also be provided to the post graduate students.

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS :

1. This MoU shall commence from the date of its execution and shall remain in force for a period of 2 calendar years from the date of its execution.
2. Upon the expiry of the term, this MoU shall at the option of the parties, be renewed from the date of expiry for a further period of \_\_\_ years on the terms and conditions to be set out fresh.
3. The Dental College shall pay the agreed charges for teaching and training expenses for a period of 4 years irrespective of the fact whether the Dental College continues to utilize facilities agreed to be extended by the Medical College under the present MoU for the said lock in period of 4 years. By way of illustration, if the Dental College does not require the said





facilities. It still require to pay to the Medical College the agreed sum of the total period of \_\_\_\_ years.

4. The teaching staff of the Medical College shall be permitted to participate in teaching programme of first, second and third BDS students as per the details of the syllabus and the time table framed by the Dental College as per the guideline of the Dental Council of India. The teaching staff of Medical College will participate in the teaching programme of Dental College after completing or before starting the teaching examination schedule of Medical College. Hence time table of Dental College is required to frame accordingly.

5. The Medical College shall provide facilities of 100 beds to the Dental College with the subject of General Medicine and General Surgery.

6. In the case of acute medical emergency related with the dental patients undergoing treatment at Oral Surgery Department and other related department, the Medical College shall render the necessary assistance in managing such patients by and through the concerned clinical departments of the Medical College.

7. Teaching and training includes delivery of lectures, conducting tutorials, seminars and practical training / clinical teaching in the departments & wards of the Hospital of the Medical College.

8. The Dean of the Dental College shall finalize the time table and teaching schedule in consultation with the Dean of the Medical College.

9. The training as per the time table mutually agreed upon by the Dental College and the Medical College shall satisfy the requirements of the Dental College as per the guidelines of the Dental Council of India and the Maharashtra University of Sciences, Nashik.

10. The Dental College shall pay an amount of Rs. 18,15,000/- (A.Y. 2021-22) to the Dean of the Medical College.

The MOU charges will be revised ;

For Financial year 2022-23 Rs 21,78,000, 2023-24 Rs 25,41,000, 2024-25 Rs 29,04,000

And thereafter the 10% per annum. (in two installments paid by Aug./Feb. of every year.)

11. That disciplinary control over the students and the staff of the dental college within the premises of the Medical College and/or the hospital of the Medical College shall be of the Medical College, through its Dean. The Dental College, through its Dean shall have the administrative control on the teaching staff of the Medical College while the staff of the Medical College is engaged in teaching and training the students of the Dental College and when they are in the premises of the Dental College.

12. The details of working schedule shall be prepared by the Dental College and shall be given well in advance to the Medical College through its Dean.

13. The list of teaching staff of the Medical College who shall be assigned this duty shall be provided to the Dental College by the Medical College at the beginning of the each academic session.

14. The teaching programme shall be monitored by the Dean of the Medical College in consultation with the Dean of the Dental College as and when necessary.

15. This MoU shall in all respects governed by and construed in accordance with the laws in force in India. This parties submit themselves to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts at Amravati.

16. No party hereto be held liable for any failure or delay in the performance of any undertaking, term or condition herein, if such failure or delay is due to any cause or causes beyond its control, including but not limited to fire, flood, damage by the elements, perils of the sea or air accident, act of God, Strike, Lock-out or other labour disorder, act of foreign or domestic de-jure or de-facto Government, whether by law, order legislation, decree, rule, regulation or otherwise, revolution, civil disturbance, breach of the peace, declared or undeclared war, act of interference or action by civil or military authorities.

17. In the event of an occurrence of exceptional circumstances likely to continue for a period of one hundred and eighty (180) days or more beyond the control of both parties, the Parties may, without prejudice to their other right contained herein, mutually discuss and decide on the measures to be taken to counter such circumstances.

18. Dispute, if any, arises relating to the execution and implementation of the present MoU as well as working and teaching under the present, MoU shall be amicably settled by discussion primarily by the Deans of the Medical College and Dental College along with one authorized representative of the Managing Trustee of both the Societies / institutions. This shall form the grievance committee whose decision shall be final and binding on both parties.



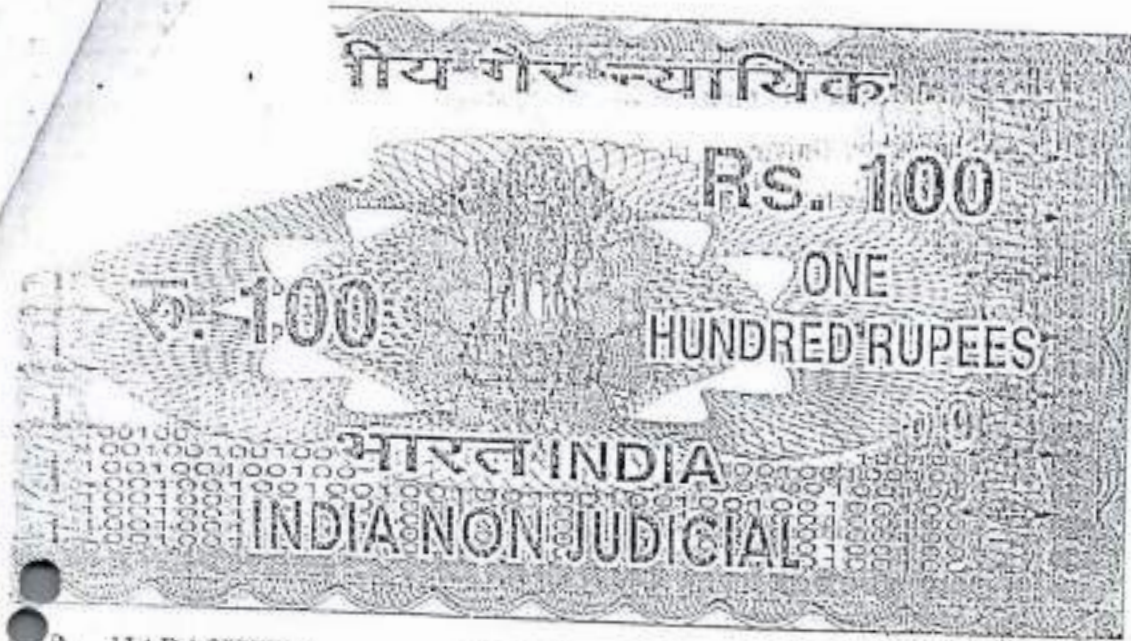

1.1 To inform the D.E.F's Deesha International Eye bank (Cell: 989-989-8667 / 8275539754 / 7378656145 which is operating round the clock) or its representative based locally about the:

- Death of an individual who has filled Eye Donation Form before death and awareness of kin ready to donate eyes of the deceased.
- Willingness mentioned by the patient to donate eyes when a patient is in critical condition
- Relatives have mentioned willingness/Consent to donate eyes of the deceased and
- Death of any individual in the hospital between the ages of 2 to 75.

1.2 To help in promoting Eye donation and Eye banking and also to help in counseling the patients for eye donation.

1.3 To allow trained counselors/technicians from D.E.F's Deesha International Eye Bank to enter the wards / Departments of the Dr Panjabrao Alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh Memorial Medical College to counsel the family of the deceased and to access the medical records of the deceased in order to screen for contraindications to eye donation.

1.4 To allow D.E.F's Deesha International Eye Bank to organize awareness sessions in Dr Panjabrao Alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh Memorial Medical College for the staff, resident doctors, UG & PG students and place posters or other suitable material in the hospital premises to promote eye donation.

1.5 A permanent contact place/office of D.E.F's Deesha International Eye Bank in any of the offices/wards with a table, chair and a cupboard for counselors / technicians of D.E.F's Deesha International Eye Bank.

1.6 To engage the Resident Doctors (PG – Ophthalmology) students in the eye retrieval work which will be beneficial for them to learn and understand eye banking and eye transplantation.

D.E.F's Deesha International Eye Bank shall provide following services to Dr Panjabrao Alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh Memorial Medical College:

2.1 The Storage mediums [MK], the instruments for tissue retrieval and counselors / technicians will be provided by D.E.F's Deesha International Eye Bank.



- 2.2 After receiving information on phone from the Hospital & Medical College, D.E.F's Deesha International Eye Bank will arrange for cornea retrieval team to reach to Dr Panjabrao Alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh Memorial Medical College as soon as possible, if the PG students are not available for retrieval.
- 2.3 The Cornea Retrieval team will obtain written Consent from the Donor family and retrieve the cornea aesthetically.
- 2.4 In order to maximize the utilization of corneal tissue and restore sight to patients in need, D.E.F's Deesha International Eye Bank has the right to use the cornea or distribute it to cornea transplanting surgeons based on a patient priority protocol.

Hence time table of Dental College is required to frame accordingly.
6. The Medical College shall provide facilities of 100 beds to the Dental College with the subject of General Medicine and General Surgery.
7. In the case of acute medical emergency related with the dental patients undergoing treatment at Oral Surgery Department and other related department, the Medical College shall render the necessary assistance in managing such patients by and through the concerned clinical departments of the Medical College.
8. Teaching and training includes delivery of lectures, conducting tutorials, seminars and practical training / clinical teaching in the departments & wards of the Hospital of the Medical College.
9. The Dean of the Dental College shall finalize the time table and teaching schedule in consultation with the Dean of the Medical College.
10. The training as per the time table mutually agreed upon by the Dental College and the Medical College shall satisfy the requirements of the Dental College as per the guidelines of the Dental Council of India and the Maharashtra University of Sciences, Nashik.
11. The Dental College shall pay an amount mentioned below towards the charges of teaching and training expenses in two installments every year, first in August and second in February with the grace period of 15 days.

WHEREAS schemes for non Government organizations (hereafter referred as NGO/PRIVATE practitioner) providing eye care implemented as per pattern of assistance approved by the Cabinet.

## 2. Parties of Mou
