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

#### **CommunityMedicine;- Teaching-Learning activities at RHTC, Nerpinglai**

The first year MBBS students visit RHTC during their foundation course for knowing the working pattern of RHTC. The college bus is available for students to reach the RHTC. They are given demonstration about the functioning of RHTC, manpower and their roles and responsibilities and the facilities available for patients in RHTC. There are three subcenters and students are taken for visit in their community posting about the rural health problems and facilities available.

Post Graduate Students from the Community Medicine department are posted at the RHTC and they have been taught about the various activities of RHTC

- Gynecologist posted at RHTC ner pinglai teach them about the ANC examination and ANC Care of Pregent Mothers and all services given to them and advice about Nutrition, rest and danger singles with advice of delivery in the health institutions.
- 2) Pediatrician posted in the RHTC train the PG students regarding the minor Ailments among the children and problems come to the children in 0 to 6 year age group with treatment of various diseases and about their immunization to mothers.
- 3) PG students run general OPD and aim is, they should be well oriented about rural problems and diseases and the rural community with treatment of serious patients and their referral to the higher centre.
- They are taught about the use of emergency drugs and handling these drugs as per the advice of physician.

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





#### Community Medicine- UG (MBBS) Teaching- Learning activities at UHTC, Belpura

- First MBBS Students are given orientation of working staff & services provided at UHTC of Dr.PDMMC, Amravati during their visit to UHTC as a part of the foundation course and 9 family visits are arranged under Family Adoption program.
- 2) Second MBBS- First Clinical Community Medicine posting of 4 weeks duration of 2<sup>nd</sup> MBBS students include 4-5 teaching learning sessions at UHTC, Belpura including Community case taking of clinicosocial cases of Communicable diseases such as Tuberculosis, Filariasis etc & chronic non communicable diseases such as Diabetes mellitus, Hypertension, geriatric health Problems such as arthritis, psychiatric illness & disabilities due to accidents, paralysis etc. 6 family visits are paid under Family adoption program
- 3) **Third MBBS-** Second clinical Community Medicine posting of 6 weeks include following teaching learning activities at UHTC, Belpura centre's OPD and 5 family visits to the allotted families under Family adoption program.
  - I) Obstetrics + Family welfare. (2 weeks)
    - i) Clinicosocial assessment of antenatal & postnatal cases
    - ii) Assessment of high-risk mothers
    - iii) Neonatal assessment
    - iv) Assessment of eligible couples of family welfare services & health education
    - v) Community based health education activities for mothers regarding hygiene, sanitation,Nutrition,immunization,Familyplanning, Breast feeding & Weaning, childrearing myths & taboos etc

#### II) Community Pediatrics & Adolescent health care (2 Weeks)

- i) Health & Nutritional assessment of under five child.
- ii) Clinicosocial case reviews of Nutrition deficiency diseases in children and childhood malnutrition.
- iii) Clinicosocial case review of common childhood in infections such as Acute Respiratory infection , fever with rash, Acute Gastroenteritis,malarial fever, Scabies, worm infestation etc.
- iv) Childhood immunization Observation of immunization session & assessment of cold chain.
- v) School health examination School environment assessment & examination of school children for Malnutrition, Anemia, Intestinal

parasites, diseases of Skin, Eye, Ear, dental caries, developmental delays etc. & health education activity for school children including adolescents regarding healthy nutrition, addictions, Sex education, Gadget use, Personal hygiene, Menstrual hygiene in girls etc.

#### III) Non Communicable diseases (2 weeks)

Clinicosocial case review of Non- communicable diseases such as Stroke, COPD, Cancer, Occupational diseases, Disabilities due to blindness, Leprosy, Polio etc

#### Community Medicine-PG & Interns Teaching- Learning activities UHTC, Belpura

The interns are posted at UHTC during their Internship program for three weeks and PG students doing M.D. Community Medicine have three postings at UHTC of one month each. Following are the activities for training interns and PG students at UHTC, Belpura

- i) LMO at UHTC (Gynecologist) teach examination of ANC mothers, ANC profile ,Iron Folic acid supplementation ,Td immunization, Dietary advice, counseling for opting Institutional deliveries, Identifying High risk mothers and referral, Post natal care and family planning services like Cu-T insertion , Condoms, OCPs, Centchroman etc.
- ii) Pediatrician teach taking History, doing clinical examination and treating common infant and childhood problems and referral of complicated cases to higher centres, Growth monitoring, counseling of mothers regarding child health and nutrition.
- iii) Immunization session- PGs and Interns learn administering various vaccines and monitor Cold chain under guidance of Pediatrician and ANM during session and conducting Pulse polio program.
- iv) PGs and Interns run General OPD including patients with Diabetes, Hypertension, Hypothyroidism etc, advise them lab investigations done at UHTC and treat and follow up them and referral whenever needed under guidance of Physician posted.
- v) Patients with skin ailments, Eye problems and Psychiatric disorders are also shown and examined and treated or referred under guidance of Dermatologist, Ophthalmologist and Psychiatrist visits at UHTC.
- vi) Minor surgical procedures like Suturing, stitch removal, dressing etc
- vii) Pathological investigations like ANC profile, Blood sugar, Urine microscopy etc are taught by Pathologist.
- viii) Emergency tray and handling emergencies if they occur and arranging urgent referral.
- ix) Community based diagnostic camps, Immunization camps etc are arranged by PGs and interns and they also participate in health camps like Pap smear arranged at UHTC.
- x) School health programs are arranged by PGs and interns.
- xi) Research activities are carried out by PGs at UHTC.
- xii) Celebration of various health related days like Menstrual hygiene day, World Health day, Breast feeding and Nutrition week etc.



#### Activity report of Camps and Celebration of Health days at UHTC

- Pap smear camp for early diagnosis of Cancer Cervix in females was conducted at UHTC, Belpura on 18/12/2018 in collaboration with Ob-Gy society, Amravati. The Pap smear of around 54 women of > 35 years was taken and report was given to them within a week. Around 6 women had dysplastic changes in Pap smear and they were referred to Dr. PDMMC for further work up and management.
- 2) Menstrual hygiene day was celebrated at UHTC, Belpura on 6/6/2019.

Around 43 nursing students and girls from local school were educated about using sanitary pads instead of cloth, maintaining genital hygiene and sanitary disposal of soaked pads with the help of Power point presentation.

3) <u>Diagnostic Camp</u> was conducted at UHTC, Belpura on 18/2/2020 on Occasion of Shivaji Jayanti. Around 224 local people of all ages and both genders were examined by Physicians, Pediatricians, Gynecologist, Ophthalmologist and Dermatologist and free medicines were distributed and referral services were provided.
