### Report of functioning of Immunization Clinic

Immunization clinic in Dr. Panjabrao alias Bhausahab Deshmukh Memorial Medical College, Hospital & Research Center Amravati is conducted by the department of Pediatrics. It is situated in the pediatrics OPD No. 18; on first floor at OPD complex building .It is functional on all working days. Immunization is carried out as Indian Academy of Pediatrics guidelines. All vaccines covered under National Immunization schedule are administered free of cost. Optional vaccine like typhoid vaccine, Hepatitis A vaccine, Varicella vaccine, Pneumococcal polysaccharide & MMR are given at concessional rates.

#### Steps:

1. All babies coming for vaccination (old + new) are registered and their demographic profile like name, age, sex, address, date of birth, any special medical condition etc. are noted by resident and faculty in the pediatrics OPD.
2. Their anthropometric measurements are taken and documented in immunization card.
3. Developments assessment of child is done and documented in case record form
4. Parents are counseled regarding optional vaccines apart from vaccine covered under National immunization program.
5. Any significant information like drug allergy, adverse event following Immunization in past is collected from the parents.
6. Vaccines are administered by In charge sister under supervision of post graduate students and faculty members
7. Proper record is kept regarding the name of vaccine, dose, site etc. in the vaccination card and vaccine record register.
8. Post vaccination advice regarding common side effects of vaccine and their management at home is given to the parents. All babies who receive vaccination are kept under observation for half an hour to observe any adverse effect following vaccination.
9. Sister in charge of vaccination clinic ensures the temperature of vaccines stored in the ILR and maintains other documents like cold chain maintenance record and vaccine stock record.
10. PG students and interns who are posted in Pediatrics Department, during their rotation posting are given hands on training in Immunization Clinic under supervision of faculty members.
